3 Qualifications for application:

- (1) Applicants should be able to conduct lectures and courses in Public Policy in the Japanese language.
- (2) Applicants should hold the following (a) or (b) or both.
 - (a) Applicants should hold a Master's degree (including Master's degree candidates who will graduate next March) or have an outstanding record equivalent to a Master's degree (including holders of the degree of Doctorate, or doctoral degree candidates who will graduate next March).
 - (b) Applicants should have public administration-related work experience at a central or local government institution.

- (4) Applicants should be 40 years of age or younger, as of October 1, 2018.
